

## **Schedule Requirements for Grades 9-12**

The following requirements need to be met between 9-12:

### **8 credits - English**

- 2 credits English 9
- 2 credits English 10
- 2 credits English 11 or College Literature and Composition
- 2 credits English 12 or College Composition

### **7 credits - Social Studies**

- 1 credit Civics
- 2 credits US History
- 2 credits Area Studies or Physical Geography and Area Studies
- 1 credit Economics or CIS Economics
- 1 credit World History or CIS World History

### **6 credits - Math**

- 2 credits Algebra 1.5, Geometry or Algebra II
- 2 credits Geometry, Algebra II or College Algebra
- 2 credits Algebra II, College Algebra or Precalculus/College Stats

### **6 credits - Science**

- 2 credits Physical Science 9
- 2 credits Biology or AP Biology
- 2 credits Physics, Chemistry or College Chemistry

### **3 credits - Physical Education/Health**

- 2 credits PE
- 1 credit Health

### **2 credits - Fine Arts**

- 2 credits 2D Art, 3D Art, College Photography, College 3D Art, Sr Band or Sr Choir

### **14 credits - Electives**

- 14 credits Elective Classes

### **Qualifying for CIS/PSEO Courses**

#### Seniors

- Cumulative GPA of **2.5** or higher at the end of your junior year
- 237 or higher on the Reading Comprehension Test for College Level Courses
- 250 or higher on the Reading Comprehension Test for College Composition
- 235 or higher on the Elementary Algebra Test for College Algebra

#### Juniors

- Cumulative GPA of **3.0** or higher at the end of your sophomore year
- 237 or higher on the Reading Comprehension Test for College Level Courses
- 250 or higher on the Reading Comprehension Test for College Composition
- 235 or higher on the Elementary Algebra Test for College Algebra

## **12<sup>th</sup> Grade**

The following are the required classes for seniors. You have multiple options to choose from in order to complete these requirements.

### **English (Choose 1 of the following options)**

1. **2 credits** - English 12
2. **2 credits** – College Composition and Literature (must qualify to take college level classes)
3. **2 credits** – College Composition (must qualify to take college level classes)

### **Social Studies (Choose 1 of the following options)**

1. **1 credit** - Economics  
**1 credit** - World History
2. **1 credit** - CIS Economics (must qualify to take college level classes)  
**1 credit** - CIS World History (must qualify to take college level classes)

### **Electives**

Students must have a minimum of 12 credits, 6 credits each semester, to have a completed schedule.

### **Spanish for Heritage Speakers:**

Students must wait until they are entering at least grade 10 to join this class. Students who are bilingual in Spanish / English at any level are encouraged to enroll in the Spanish for Heritage Speakers class with the goal of improving their literacy through extensive reading. 2. **1 credit** – PSEO Online Geography (must qualify to take college level classes)  
**1 credit** – Area Studies (1<sup>st</sup> Semester Only)

### **Math (Choose 1 of the following options)**

1. **2 credits** – College Algebra
2. **2 credits** – Algebra II

### **Science (Choose 1 of the following options)**

1. **2 credits** – Chemistry
2. **2 credits** – College Chemistry
3. **2 credits** – Physics
